HOT WEATHER REMINDER!

With summertime still upon us, it's also the time for country shows and village fetes. The heat in summer can make a dog very uncomfortable, and if it's trailing around a show with you it may become hot and dehydrated.

Heat stroke doesn't only happen when dogs are shut in cars! Be careful on hot days, especially with short nosed breeds, overweight pets or those with heart trouble. Avoid strenuous exercise when it's hot, provide plenty of fresh air and water and don't leave your pet in direct sunlight.

Main symptoms of heatstroke include violent panting, excessive drooling, vomiting, red eyes and gums, collapse or unconsciousness. Wet your dog's coat with cold water, put your pet somewhere cool and **call a vet immediately**.
